Uniform Instructions

Due to needing space in the trailer and bus transportation shortages, we are changing how the uniform process works. They will no longer be transported on the trailer/racks.

No eating will be allowed while in uniform due to the difficulty and cost of getting them dry cleaned.

Details based on the type of performance:
Western Welcome Week parade /Football games:

- Student transport to WWW Parade and football games will be on their own or parent/guardian. Students will take the uniforms home after school/Thursday rehearsal & return uniforms to school the following school day.
- ➤ WWW Parade: arrive at Ketring Park in uniform. Do not bring your instrument case, garment bag, shako box, or any other personal items as there is no place to store them, and you won't return to the park after the parade. Please leave those in your car or with a parent/guardian.
- ➤ Football games: Arrive in uniforms for Star Spangled Banner. Halves for 1st/2nd quarter, full uniform for show run at halftime. Get out of uniform and hang them on the stands during the 3rd quarter. Students will have 3rd off. Play for 4th quarter.

Show Days

- >Student transport will be by bus. Students should be wearing their show shirts and something that they can comfortably wear underneath their uniform.nPlease don't wear anything that you must remove to get uniforms on.
- ➤ Rehearse in the morning: Students pack everything up. Grab uniforms from racks as the very last thing before leaving. Students load buses with uniforms hung on bus racks.
- ➤ Arrive at competition, and unload trailer/props, head back to buses & Get changed on buses. Leave garment bags/shako boxes on the buses.
- >Perform/ Head to buses, change, and head to the Trailer to load.
- **≻Eat, Watch shows, etc**

Students will take home their uniform after school on Friday. Students should plan on being dropped off close to the meeting spot in full uniform (plumes will be provided at the parade). Students should also plan on leaving cases, shako boxes, and other items in the car as there will be no place to store them at the parade. Uniforms will be returned to school the following Monday morning. (These must be properly hung at any time they are not on the person)

Students will be allowed to wear a personal camelbak, so long as it doesn't distract from the uniform, meaning underneath.
